Notes:

1. The average daily parcel volume is calculated by dividing the total parcel volume by the number of calendar days in the corresponding period, which is 90 days for both the first quarter of 2026 and the first quarter of 2025;
2. Except for the number of sorting centers and automated sorting machines, other data is rounded to the nearest approximation;
3. Other business models are still being explored and optimized, and are not disclosed here;
4. The decrease in the number of network partners and outlets in China was mainly due to the fact that the Company optimized the network structure in China to enhance the operating capacity of a single network partner and outlet;
5. The increase in the number of outlets in others was mainly due to the growth in parcel volume and the opening of new outlets;
6. The increase in the number of sorting centers was mainly due to the rapid growth in the parcel volume, which boosted the demand for production capacity;
7. The increase in the line-haul vehicles in SEA was mainly due to the rapid growth in the Company's parcel volume during the Ramadan Shopping Festival, which boosted the demand for line-haul vehicles.

Please note that all figures above are unaudited and have not been confirmed by the Company's auditors and may be subject to adjustment and final confirmation. Shareholders and potential investors of the Company are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
